



Second Quarter 2024 Trends & Our Response


- Robbery:** Napa resident (no ties to Yountville) forcefully tried to take personal property and a vehicle. Arrested for H&S 11550, PC 211, PC 215. The case went through the court system and resolved with jail time/probation.
- Domestic Violence:** Female hotel guest was arrested for DV on her husband. No Yountville residents involved. Case is still pending in the court system.
- Crimes against property-** We had one report of burglary (tools from vehicle) one grand theft (cell phone from vehicle) and one report of vandalism.
