RECOMMENDATION

Waive Second Reading of Ordinance Number 24-530 amending Sections 8.28.020 and 8.28.060 of Chapter 8.28 of Title 8 of the Yountville Municipal Code Regarding Smoking in Public Places and finding Amendments exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

At the August 6, 2024 meeting, Town Council introduced and held a first reading of this Ordinance. This is the second reading, and if adopted, the Ordinance will take effect in 30 days. The Ordinance amends Sections 8.28.020 and 8.28.060 of Chapter 8.28 of Title 8 of the Yountville Municipal Code Regarding Smoking in Public Places and find Amendments exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
