

**RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 112**

**RESOLUTION REQUESTING CONSENT OF THE CITIES OF AMERICAN CANYON, CALISTOGA, NAPA, AND ST. HELENA AND THE TOWN OF YOUNTVILLE TO RENEW THE NAPA VALLEY TOURISM IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors (the “Board”) of the County of Napa (the “County”) desires to begin proceedings to renew the Napa Valley Tourism Improvement District (“NVTID”); and

**WHEREAS**, certain lodging business owners have requested that the Board renew the NVTID; and

**WHEREAS**, a portion of the territory proposed to be included in the NVTID lies within the boundaries of the cities of American Canyon, Calistoga, Napa, and St. Helena, and the Town of Yountville (the “cities and town”), as shown on the map attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by such attachment; and

**WHEREAS**, the area of the cities and town which lies within the boundaries of the proposed NVTID will, in the opinion of the Board, be benefited by the improvements and activities, and the purpose sought to be accomplished by the work can best be accomplished by a single comprehensive scheme of work.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of the County that:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2: Consent of the cities and town, through their respective City Councils and Town Council, is hereby requested to renew the NVTID, and to grant to the Board jurisdiction for all the purposes in connection with creation, operation, and future renewals of the proposed NVTID.




