RECOMMENDATION

Waive Second Reading and Adopt Ordinance Number 25-531 amending Section 6.04.010 and adding Section 6.04.100 of Chapter 6.04 of Title 6 of the Yountville Municipal Code regarding potentially dangerous and vicious animals and enforcement of same and finding the Ordinance exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

At the February 18, 2025 regular meeting, Town Council introduced and waived the first reading of Ordinance Number 25-531. This is the Second Reading, and if adopted, Ordinance 25-531 will take effect in 30 days. The Ordinance amends Section 6.04.010 and adds Section 6.04.100 of Chapter 6.04 of Title 6 of the Yountville Municipal Code regarding potentially dangerous and vicious animals and enforcement of same and find exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).
