**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF YOUNTVILLE  
ADOPTING RESOLUTION 24-4286 APPROVING THE CLOSURE OF WASHINGTON  
STREET FOR THE 30<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE FRENCH LAUNDRY SPECIAL EVENT  
(EVNT-24-5) ON SATURDAY, JULY 6, 2024 FROM 12:01 AM ON JULY 6, 2024 TO 6:00 AM  
ON JULY 7, 2024**

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### Recitals

- A. The Town of Yountville approves many special events throughout the year to enhance our community and sense of place.
- B. The French Laundry and Thomas Keller Restaurant Group have applied for a special event permit for its 30-year celebration.
- C. This is a momentous celebration for the restaurant and legacy it has within the Town.
- D. The event holder has hired a traffic control management company to provide a traffic control plan that will need to be reviewed and finalized by Public Works prior to the event.
- E. In order to provide amplified sound and create a larger space for activity, the event holder is requesting the closure of Washington street from Humboldt/Jefferson to Starkey on Washington Street and closure of Creek Street (accessible at any time to residents).

**Now, therefore, the Town Council of the Town of Yountville does resolve as follows:**

- 1. The Town Council hereby approves the street closure of Washington Street from Humboldt/Jefferson to Starkey and Creek Street for the special event permit for The French Laundry's 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Party from July 6<sup>th</sup> at 12:01 am until July 7<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 am.
- 2. The Resolution is hereby adopted and becomes effective and in full force immediately upon adoption.

### **Interim Off-Lease Dog Park Regulations**

#### **PASSIVE POOCH AREA**

- Lower-energy play
- Roaming, sniffing and socializing
- All size of dogs welcome

#### **ACTIVE EXERCISE AREA**

- High-energy Play
- Fetch, run, chase, and play encouraged
- All size of dogs welcome

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- Hours 8 AM – Dusk
- No excessive barking.
- Dogs must always be monitored by their owner.
- Dogs must be on leash when coming and going and until they enter the holding area and both gates are closed.
- Dogs must be under voice control.
- Grooming is not allowed.
- All dogs must be healthy, licensed, over 4 months old and be currently vaccinated.
- Absolutely no female dogs in heat are allowed.
- Smoking or vaping is not allowed.
- Food is not allowed.
- Glass is not allowed.
- All children under 13 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- Owners are responsible for the acts and conduct of their animal.
- Park users and dog owners assume all risks related to the use of the dog park.
- For the safety of all dogs, immediately leash your dog if it exhibits aggressive behavior and leave the dog park area.
- **You are required to clean up after your dog. Waste bags and receptacles are available.**
- ALL dog bites must be reported to Napa County Animal Control 707-253-4452
