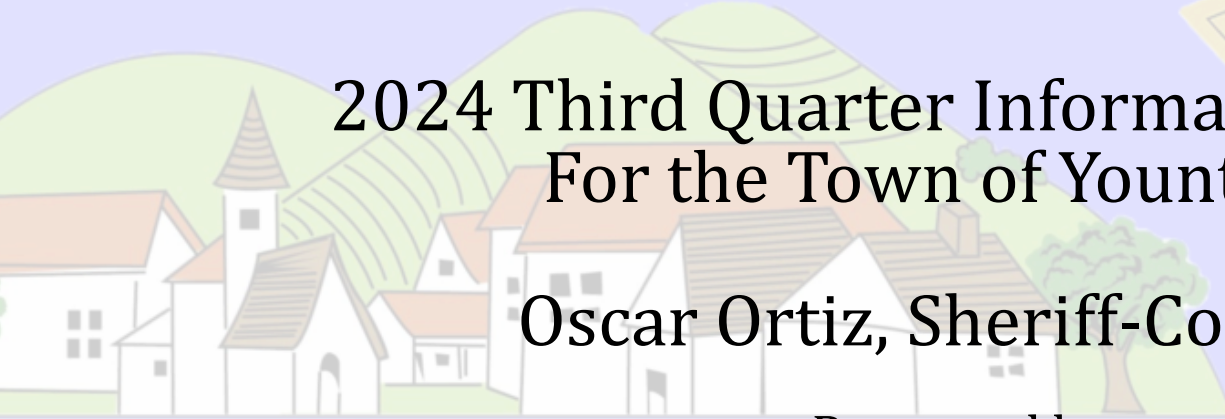

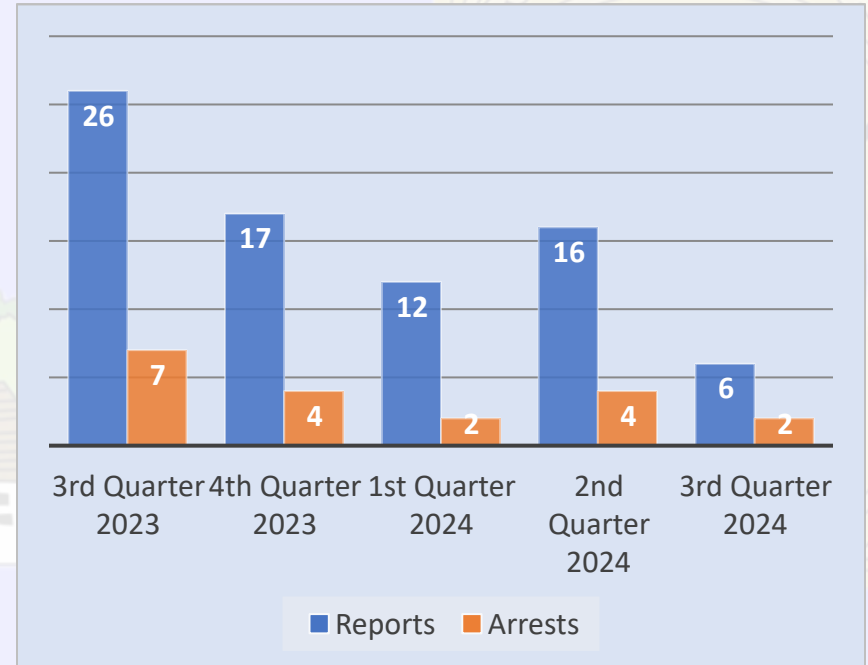
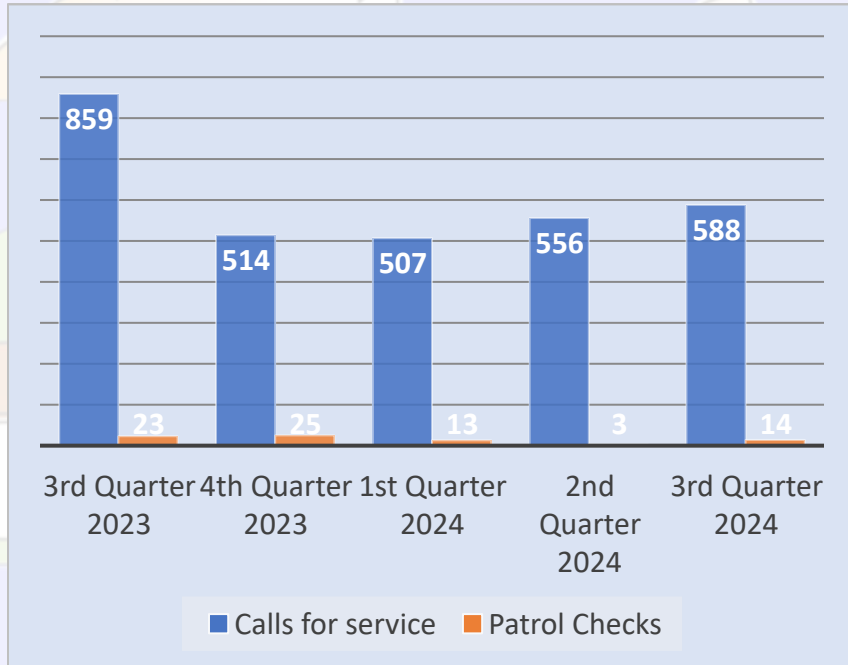

Arrest/Search Warrant:

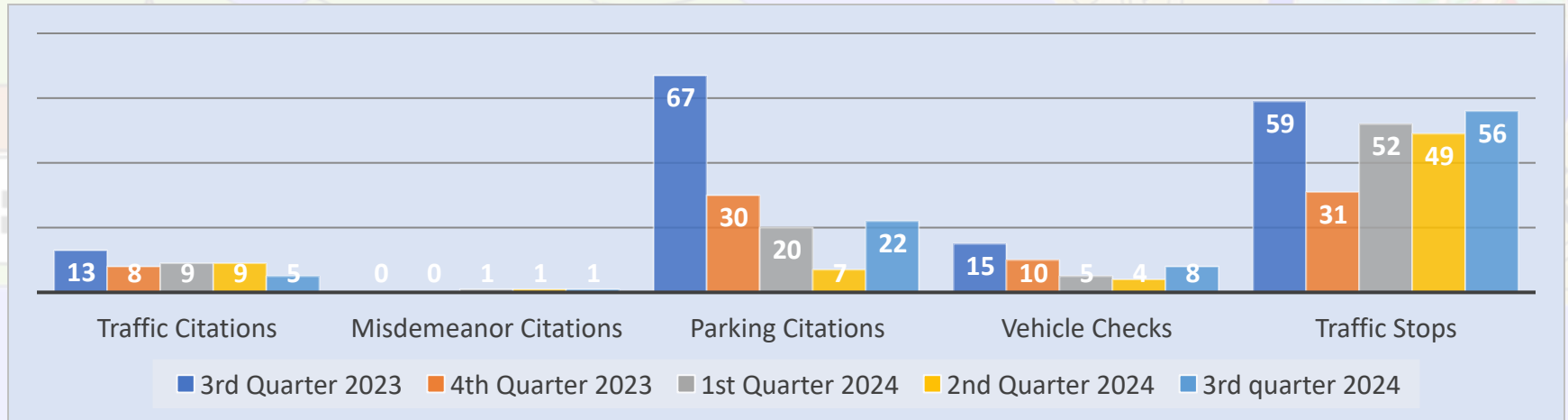
