#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Second Reading and Adoption of Ordinance Number 23-525, an Ordinance of the Town Council of the Town of Yountville, Reclassifying the Finance Director/Treasurer position to Administrative Services Director and updating the Yountville Municipal Code to reflect the reclassification.

#### **DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND**

At the November 21, 2023 Town Council meeting, the Council introduced and held a first reading of this Ordinance. This is the second reading and, if adopted, the Ordinance will take effect in 30 days. The Ordinance adds section 2.28.050 to the Town's Municipal Code, which would clarify that all references in the code to "Finance Director/Treasurer," "Finance Director," and/or "Treasurer" also mean "Administrative Services Director." Section 2.28.050 would also clarify that the Administrative Services Director exercises all powers and duties of the Finance Director/Treasurer.
