Sculpture Relocation Plan (Informational Item)

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

Following the discussion on the Pioneer Trail concept and movement of sculptures and artifacts, we would like to provide an update on pending relocations of Art Walk sculptures that you may see in the following months. The sculptures will be moved by the Town Public Works Team.

TOWN HALL

- Slingshot owned by the Town will be relocated to the front of North Block Hotel. The Hotel has verbally approved this move and it is pending contract signatures. Untitled is currently in this location and is timing out in October and will be removed by the artist.
- The YES Book sculpture owned by the Town will be moved to the Yountville Commons site adjacent to the "Memory Wall" on the back side of the campus where the handprints are. The existing Yountville School sign will also be relocated to that area to create a memorial space paying homage to Yountville School.
- The new George C. Yount sculpture will be located at Town Hall frontage.
- The Yount Millstones will be moved from the front of the Community Hall to the front of Town Hall adjacent to the new Yount sculpture.

HOPPER CREEK PARK

- Discussion with the estate of Jack Chandler will occur to potentially move Mare and Foal to the front of Town Hall.
- Raven Story currently located in Hopper Creek Park will be requested to be moved to Washington Street where Who Rescued Who currently resides. Who Rescued Who's term has ended and is being removed by the artist. Timeline for this is pending.

COMMUNITY HALL

- A 4 x 4 pad will open up in front of the Community Hall for future sculpture placement once the Yount Millstones are moved.
