RECOMMENDATION

Adopt Resolution Number 24-4332 reciting the facts of the Consolidated General Municipal Election held on November 5, 2024 and declaring the result and such other matters as provided by law.

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

On June 4, 2024, the Town Council Adopted Resolution Number 24-4275 providing for the Holding of a Consolidated General Municipal Election (Election) to be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, for the purpose of electing two (2) Council Members.

Eric Knight, Robert D. Moore, Pam Reeves, and Joe Tagliaboschi were nominated for the offices of Council Member of the Town of Yountville. The top two highest vote-getters for the Council Member positions will each serve for a four-year term.

Voters cast their ballots in the Election to elect two (2) Council Members. The total number of registered voters in the Town of Yountville at the time of the election was 1,757. Of the 1,757 registered voters, 1,465 cast their ballot for a total voter turnout of 83.38%. The Consolidated Elections gives the Napa County Election Official 28 days to complete the canvass which falls on Tuesday, December 3, 2024. The County Election Official, upon completion of the canvass, will transmit the results to the local municipalities. On December 3, 2024, the Napa County Registrar of Voters provided the Town with the Official Certified Results and Statement of Vote.
