I humbly ask that you give your consideration to my request as listed below.

The variance would alleviate a unique and unusual hardship to the occupant (me) — that being safety and well being. The present open space (atrium) area is located in the most vulnerable and highly secluded area of the property. This portion of the property is hidden from any and all neighbors, as well as street / sidewalk traffic. There are currently two doors leading to the outside atrium area, one being from the master bedroom. Due to remoteness of the area, it would be very possible for an intruder to easily gain entry to the master bedroom, I'm a 74 year old senior citizen and will be living on my own. Having such easy access into my bedroom leaves me very uncomfortable, and quite frankly frightened. Additionally, the remote area gains very little sunlight, making it very claustrophobic and having algae grow on the concrete throughout the year, causing it to be literally unusable for enjoyment at all. In this instance, the present ordinance causes severe practical difficulty. The area is not at all usable for any type of use as it currently stands.
