Other volunteer experience includes conducting petition drives for State ballot initiatives to increase tobacco control and prevention and developed educational database for American Lung Association. I currently serve on the Hopper Creek Village Home Owner Association (HOA) Board of Directors (BOD) in a voluntary capacity. My responsibilities include chairing the Architectural Review Committee and developing and maintaining a HOA website. I also create email communications to Home owners as requested by the HOA BOD. I have been responsive to Home owner concerns and provide the most accurate information and resources to Home owners to maintain a healthy and safe living environment.

I am always looking for ways to improve my psychological and physical health and feel fortunate that I live in a town that prioritizes the health and welfare of their residents.
