As a past event planner I am capable of supporting events as they are while seeing ways that things can be improved upon. Also, in addition to being an artist, I'm creative at marketing sense and am able to come up with event names and cop. I can write releases and pieces such as "Art has a Seat at the Table".

In addition to serving as a commissioner the last two years, I was co-chair of the Home Winemakers Classic in 2021, and a team-oriented volunteer in 2019 and 2020 (which was unfortunately cancelled).
