It seems the opposition to the Three Weirs Park ADA Parking Project, as previously submitted, has taken on a life of its own. The good that's come out of all of this is the residents of Washington Park feel a greater sense of community amongst themselves. The proposed ADA project has certainly become a vehicle for us to get to know our neighbors better, as we stand in unity in our commitment to preserve the green space, also known as "Three Weirs Park".

Recently, I informed you that we would be gathering signatures on a petition in opposition to the proposed project, as previously and currently designed. To date, we have gathered 47 signatures supporting the preservation of our green space. I have attached a copy of the petition for your records. While 47 signatures may not be viewed as a lot, our community is very small and I think those signatures speak volumes. Furthermore, there was not one person we asked for signature that supported the Town's current plan for the ADA parking. The residents feel strongly that the preservation of the park is of utmost importance. We DO support a modified plan of the existing approach to the bridge, should it become necessary to become ADA compliant.
