Adopt Resolution Number 22-4151 Authorizing the filing of a Notice of Completion and accepting the work for the Community Center Generator Project CF-0028 performed by Napa Electric for a total contract amount of \$149,830.00.

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

At the May 4, 2021, Town Council meeting, Council authorized an Agreement with Napa Electric Inc. to perform electrical work on the Community Hall stationary generator and automatic switchgear to provide emergency power to the Community Center and Community Hall in the contract amount of \$135,300 using a CalOES Community Power Resiliency Grant.

The Community Center's central location allows us to assist residents in Yountville and the adjacent area that are subject to actual loss of power in PSPS events. The stationary generator on-site has sufficient capacity to power both buildings at the same time in the event of an emergency. The project completed the following components:

- · Work to connect the existing stationary emergency generator to the Community Center
- Work to connect an Automatic Transfer Switch at Community Hall
- Work to connect an Automatic Transfer Switch at Community Center

The project required 2 additional change orders totaling \$14,530.00 to complete the project.

Awarded Bid Price \$135,300.00
Change Order Additions \$14,530.00
Total Project Cost \$149,830.00

The work has been completed to the satisfaction of the Public Works Department. By this resolution, the Town Council authorizes the Director of Public Works to execute the Notice of Completion and directs the Town Clerk to file said Notice of Completion with the Napa County Clerk Recorder.
