DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

Artist: SAM CHAPMAN

Exhibit: Thurs Jan 13, 2022 thru Fri April 8.

Medium: Large oil paintings including those above inspired by photographs taken on a visit to Claude Monet's house and garden in Giverny, France in 2018.

The artist returned to Napa three years ago.

Raised in Napa and a graduate of Napa High School, I worked my way through college as a reporter/editor at the Napa Valley Register. I returned to Napa after law school at U.C., Berkeley and began a law practice, followed by running for the Napa County Board of Supervisors, being elected, and serving two terms.

I served as a congressional Chief of Staff, in Washington, D.C. and California, for over 20 years, eventually returning to journalism as an editor and publisher, and later served as Director of State and Community Relations at Lawrence Berkeley National Laboratory. I studied art with, among others, Chester Arnold and Craig Coss at College of Marin and have been painting since 2015.
