

Adopt Resolution Number 21-4074 Approving Professional Service Agreement with BPR to provide contracted plan check, building inspection, and building official services, and optional code enforcement, technology consulting, and IT support, in the amount of \$125,000.

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

Since 2015 the Town of Yountville has contracted with Interwest Consulting Group to provide contracted plan check and building inspection services as needed on a part-time basis. Until recently, the Town has been satisfied with these services. However, when Interwest was purchased by Safe-Built we began to see the quality of our relationship and these services decline.

Three of the Town's primary contacts with Interwest have since started their own consulting firm – BPR – and staff now seeks to transition services to this group to maintain the high-quality relationships and services to which we have become accustomed. We anticipate this change in services to be seamless as we will be working with many of the same people and subject to the same approved budget for these services for Fiscal Year 2021-22.

In addition to plan check, building inspection, and building official services, BPR also provides code enforcement, technology consulting, and IT support. The attached Professional Services Agreement includes these optional additional services.

Staff recommends adoption of the resolution in order to continue these important services within the Town.
