Adopt Resolution 22-4125 Authorizing Continued Remote Teleconference Meetings of the Town Council and All Town Boards, Commissions, and Committees Pursuant to Government Code Section 54953(e).

DISCUSSION/BACKGROUND

The Legislature passed and the Governor signed AB 361, which allows modified teleconferencing under the Ralph M. Brown Act (Government Code section 54950 et seq.) (the "Brown Act") if the Town Council makes certain findings: (1) at its first meeting using these procedures, (2) not later than 30 days after that meeting, and (3) every 30 days thereafter.

At its January 11, 2022 special meeting, the Town Council for itself and other legislative bodies of the Town made the necessary findings for using these procedures. The attached Resolution makes the necessary findings not later than 30 days after that meeting.

AB 361 allows teleconferencing if certain procedures are followed including: (1) notice of the meeting must be given as otherwise required by the Brown Act, (2) members of the public must be permitted to attend and participate by call-in option and/or internet-based service option, (3) if the meeting broadcast or access to participation is disrupted (e.g., by issues with technology), the Town cannot take further action on agenda items until public access to the meeting is restored, (4) the Town cannot require public comments be submitted in advance, but may still offer this option, and real-time participation by members of the public must be allowed, (5) if the Town provides a timed public comment period for an agenda item (e.g., 20 minutes per agenda item), it cannot close public comment until that time period has concluded, and (6) if the Town does not provide a timed public comment period for each agenda item, then it must allow a reasonable amount of time for members of the public to participate.
